

## Conrad Spirrison Memorial Scholarship Application



**The Conrad Spirrison Memorial Scholarship** was established in 2022 to provide financial assistance to an undergraduate student preparing for a career in education. Dr. Spirrison was the father of Holly Baker and Co-Pilot of Sophia Spirrison, both Pilot members of the Midwest District. Conrad was passionate in his support of Pilot international's endeavors for many years. Dr. Spirrison was a lifelong student who became an educator and administrator. His family is honored to sponsor a scholarship in his memory.

### Eligibility:

- Graduating high school seniors and/or full-time undergraduate students who have completed at least 12 credit hours in a college or university in the United States or Canada at the time of submitting the application. Must remain a full-time student for the duration of the scholarship.
- Have at the time of application and maintain a cumulative grade point average of a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or a 4.0 on a 5.0 scale.
- Career goal(s) in education.
- Awards are based on community service, financial need, academic success, and application contents.

### Details:

- Scholarships are awarded for one academic year.
- Award amounts may vary but will not exceed \$1,000.00 per year.
- One scholarship will be awarded each year.

### Application Deadline:

**March 15, 2024, 5:00 p.m. (EDT).** All required documents must be submitted in PDF format to [PIFFscholarships@pilothonline.org](mailto:PIFFscholarships@pilothonline.org)

### Requirements:

The following documents must be submitted to be considered for this scholarship:

- Application form.
- Financial form included as part of the application regarding your finances for 2024-25.
- Your resume. Please include an attachment to include extracurricular and/or community activities if not on your resume.
- A current original transcript with current cumulative GPA (does not need to be officially sealed).
- Proof that you submitted your FAFSA for the 2024-25 academic year.
- Financial need essay: Explain your need for this scholarship and how this scholarship can assist you.
- Career Goals Essay: type a short essay describing your career goals and how this scholarship can help you achieve these goals.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation dated within 12 months from teachers, professors, faculty advisors or employers.
- Proof of acceptance to a college or university for the 2024-25 Academic Year.

## Policies for all Pilot International Scholarships

1. The Executive Committee of Pilot International will provide the overall administration of the scholarship funds.
2. The Scholarship Committee will review and grade scholarship applications and make recommendations to the Executive Committee of Pilot International. The Scholarship Committee will recommend as recipients of scholarships those persons who in the sole judgment of the committee are best suited to further the purposes of the fund.
3. Scholarship funds may be used for tuition and related educational expenses considered necessary by the Executive Committee. Actual amounts awarded may vary.
4. In accordance with IRS regulations, officers, directors, trustees, employees, or current members of the Scholarship Committee of Pilot International are not eligible for scholarship programs sponsored by Pilot International.
5. When an application has been approved, the scholarship recipient will be notified and payment will be made in one installment directly to the applicant's educational institution upon receipt of the appropriate forms.
6. Once approved, a student may reapply annually by submitting an updated application and supporting documentation for those scholarships that are renewable.
7. A scholarship applicant is limited to one scholarship award annually. If an applicant is eligible for more than one scholarship, the Scholarship Committee will decide on the scholarship most appropriate for the individual.
