## Ten Characteristics of Effective Teams

- 1. The **Purpose** or reason for the Team's existence is clear.
- 2. **Priorities**, or the order of what needs to be done by Team, is clear.
- 3. Roles, or the positions Team members hold, are clearly defined.
- 4. **Decisions** are made by consensus or following parliamentary procedure.
- 5. **Conflict** must be dealt with quickly and openly in a healthy Team.
- 6. **Communication** must be open and members need to ask questions to clarify their understanding.
- 7. The **Climate** is warm, open, and fun!
- 8. The **Personal Traits** of individual members are well utilized.
- 9. Leadership is always well informed and prepared.
- 10. Participation and Involvement is needed by all Team members.

Remember: The foundation of any effectively functioning team is TRUST. Trust takes time, effort and attention to build . . . but can be eroded quickly with a single action.
