What should I wear?

- » Wednesday June 27 – NASH BASH Welcome Party & Donor Reception – Western Attire
- » Thursday, June 28 - Opening Sessions - Business
- » Friday, June 29 - Pilot Shirt
- » Saturday, June 30 - Business Casual
- » Installation Banquet – Cocktail Evening Wear

What will the weather be like?

Summertime in Nashville is hot. Prepare for outside temperatures up to 90°F during the day. Be sure to keep hydrated and stay in the shade when you can. The night temperatures usually range from 60°F–70°F.

Where are we staying?

The Gaylord Opryland Hotel is full of fun and exciting things to see. With lots of restaurants, shops, beautiful greenery and exotic plants throughout, it is a great place to hold this year's Convention. The Gaylord Hotel is also a short walking distance from Opry Mills Mall (with shops and restaurants) and the Grand Ole Opry House. How do we get from the airport to our hotel?

Gaylord Opryland offers an airport shuttle for \$19 (one way) or \$30 (round trip). To purchase your airport shuttle, click [here!](#) Taxis are also available at the airport and cost around \$20-\$25 one-way. The hotel is located just a quick 10 miles from the Nashville International Airport (BNA).

How much is it to park if we're driving/renting a car?

Parking at the Gaylord Opryland will be \$15 per day for our group. This rate applies if you are staying overnight, or choosing to stay off-site and driving in.

Where can I rent a scooter or wheelchair?

How will I know where to go in the hotel?

If you will be arriving between 10am-4:30pm on Wednesday June 27th, you will be welcomed by the Tennessee District Pilots near the Hotel Registration Desk! They will be wearing royal blue shirts with the Pilot International logo on the front. These wonderful Pilots are here to help make sure you get to the general area of your room location. The Gaylord Opryland has 4 different atriums (Cascades, Delta, Magnolia and Conservatory) where sleeping rooms and restaurants are located. You will receive a map of the hotel at check-in, but our Tennessee Pilots are happy to welcome and help all ya'!! We are so looking forward to seeing all of our Pilots in Nashville!

Registration for Convention will be located in the Tennessee Ballroom Lobby A which is located in the Magnolia Atrium of the hotel in the Convention Center. Registration will be from 11:00 AM – 6:00 PM on Wednesday June 27th.

If I purchased tickets to the Grand Ole Opry and/or Wildhorse Saloon off-site excursions, where do I pick up my tickets?

We will have the tickets available for you to pick up near the main Convention Registration Desk. Signs will be posted for Grand Ole Opry and Wildhorse Saloon. Tickets must be picked up no later than 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday June 27th.

Are there Restaurants in the hotel?

Yes, there are 14 full-service restaurants and 5 specialty shops for on-the-go food and beverages.

What are the hours for the Expo and where is it located?
