



Elizabeth Leonard Pilot Club Builder Award

The Elizabeth Leonard Pilot Club Builder Award honors Elizabeth Leonard who was instrumental in establishing the first Pilot Club in Macon, Georgia, as well as the international organization. The award recognizes a Pilot who does an exemplary job of building clubs to enhance the presence of Pilot International.

Requirements:

The nominee shall be current in all Pilot International obligations, both financial and procedural as defined in the Pilot International Bylaws and Policies. A recipient cannot repeat winning this award for two years following the year they last received it.

Entries must be submitted electronically by May 15 and may include documentation from May 1 of the previous Pilot year through April 30 of the current Pilot year. Submit your entry to claire@pilothonq.org.

Determination of the recipient will be made by an Awards Committee appointed by the Pilot International President and approved by the Executive Committee. The award will be given annually only if qualified applicants meet the stipulated criteria.
