Requirements:

The nominee shall be current in all PI obligations, both financial and procedural as defined in the Pilot International Bylaws and Policies.

Entries must be submitted electronically by May 15 and may include documentation from May 1 of the previous Pilot year through April 30 of the current Pilot year. Submit your entry to claire@pilothonline.org.

Determination of the recipient will be made by an Awards Committee appointed by the Pilot International President and approved by the Executive Committee. The award is given annually if qualified applicants meet the stipulated criteria.
